# JACKSON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS VOTING MEETING MINUTES

## November 16, 2023

The November 16, 2023, workshop voting meeting of the Jackson Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Grinnell at 7 PM. In attendance were Chairman Jay Grinnell, Supervisor Marianne Hall and Township Manager Chris Rearick.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**

Tom Pasterick, 143 Youngblood Road, expressed concern on Youngblood Road and requested the Township consider potential traffic calming and re-installation of temporary speed bumps.

Cathy Rape, 769 Spring Street, inquired as to the Township's intended use of Brenckle Property and suggested that the Township building upon wetlands on the site as an educational amenity in partnership with the school district. The Township Manager and Board of Supervisors agreed and noted preservation of the wetlands would be overseen.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. On a motion by Osterwise seconded by Hall, to approve the release of financial security for Seneca Trails Phase 1 and Phase 2A as recommended by the Township Engineer, the motion passed unanimously.
- 2. On a motion by Grinnell seconded by Osterwise, to advertise the adoption of the 2024 Jackson Township Annual Budget, the motion passed unanimously.
- 3. On a motion by Grinnell seconded by Hall, to appoint Derek Walker for the operator/mechanic position in the Township Road Department at a rate of \$29.50 per hour, the motion passed unanimously.
- 4. On a motion by Hall seconded by Grinnell, to adopt Resolution 23-17 authorizing submission of Local Share Account (LSA) grant application and designating authorized signers, the motion passed unanimously.
- 5. On a motion by Grinnell seconded by Osterwise, to approve a waiver reducing degradation fee for Peoples Gas for project on Pattison Street Extension, the motion passed unanimously.

There being no other business before the Board, on a motion by Hall seconded by Grinnell, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 PM.
